

## **Branch Briefing: 8**

TUC MARCH AND RALLY, SATURDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2022, LONDON – ITS NEXT WEEK!

UNISON Supporting the TUC "BRITAIN NEEDS A PAY RISE" march and rally in London.

The march in London is NEXT WEEK - JUST AFTER OUR ANNUAL DELEGATE CONFERENCE. Enclosed below are some important resources, including videos, as to why we are marching and what to expect. The TUC aim to have a well organised, inclusive event, with full access for disabled members, that will involve a 1.7 mile march from Portland Square (beginning at 12 noon) to Parliament Square for a Rally (1.00pm to 2.30pm).

# THE UNISON BLOCK WILL BE AT THE FRONT OF THE MARCH SO MAKE YOUR WAY TO PORTLAND PLACE AND LOOK FOR THE TWO BALLOONS.

- Our Senior Stewards will be at the meet up point from 8am on 18 June Portland Place in front of the BBC. Our "A Team" consists of 16 UNISON staff members who will act as stewards.
- Our area will be marked out with a "magic rope" at the front of the march held by 6 UNISON Stewards. Both sides of Portland Place will be closed to traffic from 10am.
- There will be 2 helium spheres held by UNISON Stewards.
- There will be 300 placards available.
- There will be a walking banner for the front of our section.
- There will be 1000 whistles to give out.
- There will be 500 flags available.
- Hashtags for social media are (at the moment) #unisontheunion and #DemandBetter
- There will be a professional photographer recording the event for us.
- First aid at the march is the responsibility of the TUC we will need to get hold of a TUC steward in the event of needing a first aider.

#### **GETTING THERE BY TRAIN**

The TUC have reported better news about trains. The engineering works affecting the West coast main line should not affect departure times, but there may be slight delays in getting there.

Avanti have said the timetable for the 18th June is now confirmed so the times you are now seeing will be the times that the trains will be departing. The alternative route just looks to have added a few minutes on to the usual duration - most trains taking about 2 hours 10 mins - 2 hours 20 mins.
